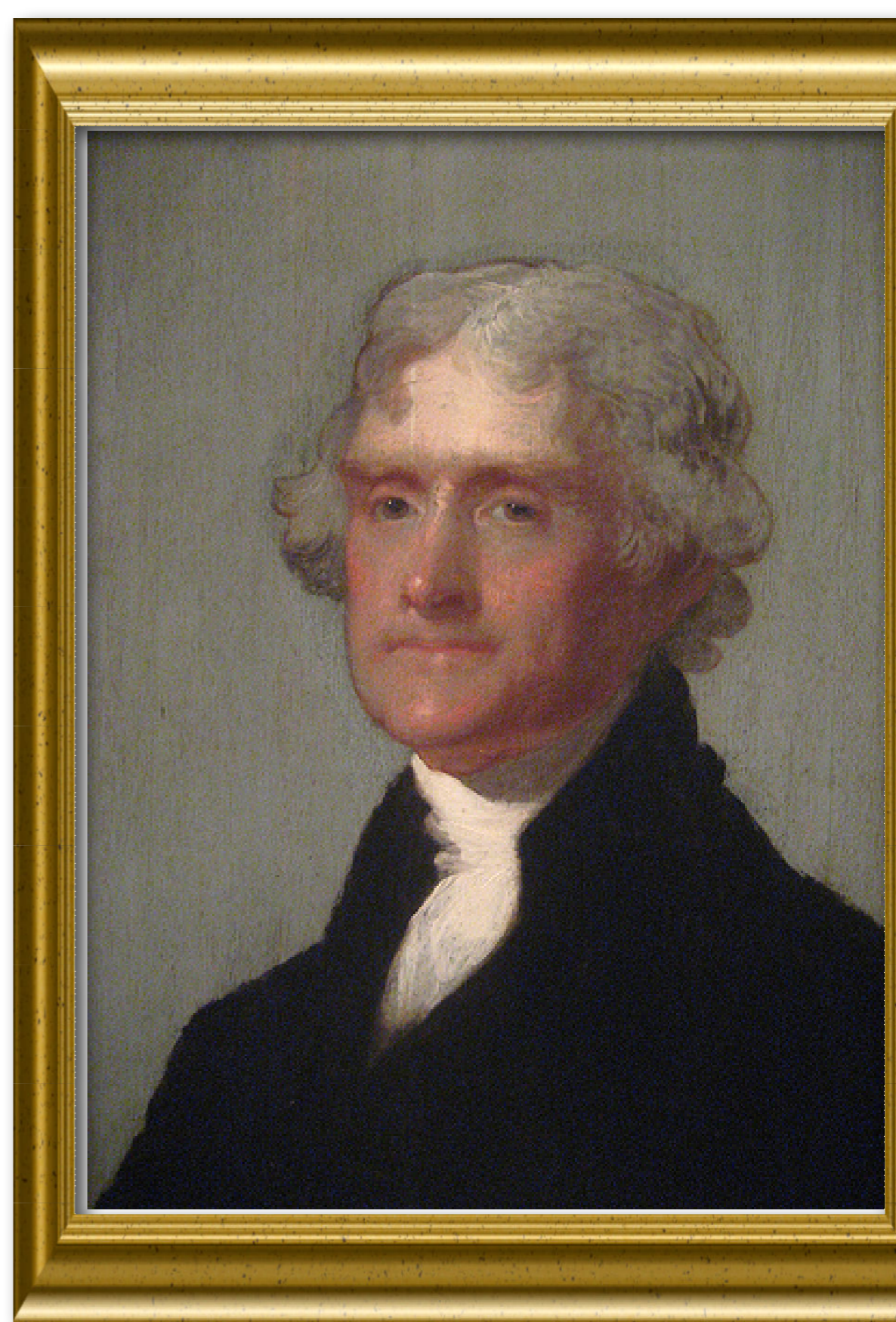



- *currency exchange*



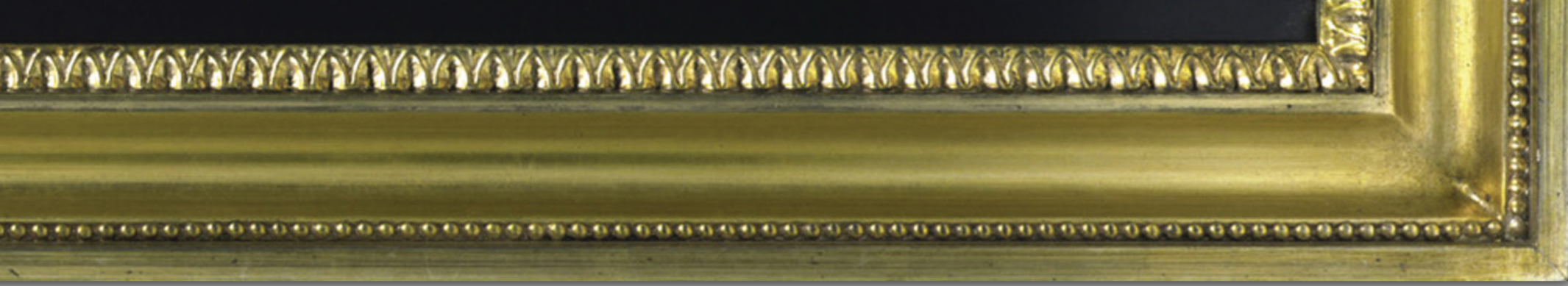
He also gained intimate knowledge of:
